The TYC General Administrative Policy Manual, Chapter 85, Subchapter B, Rule 23, defines the following offense classifications:

Sentenced Offenders: juveniles given a "determinate sentence" by the courts which, depending on behavior, may be completed in the adult prison system.

Type A Violent Offenders: juveniles classified for committing or attempting murder, capital murder, aggravated sexual assault, or sexual assault.

Type B Violent Offenders: juveniles classified for committing or attempting a violent offense other than murder or sexual assault.

Chronic Serious Offenders: juveniles adjudicated on at least three separate occasions for having committed a felony.

Controlled Substance Dealers: juveniles classified for felony-level drug manufacturing or delivery.

Firearms Offenders: juveniles who possessed a firearm during the offense for which classified.

Violation of CINS Probation: juveniles who violated a condition of their Conduct Indicating a Need for Supervision probation.

General Offenders: All other juveniles - generally sent to TYC for non-violent or property crime offenses.

New Commitments: juveniles committed to TYC for the first time.

Recommitments: juveniles previously committed to TYC who are again committed by the court.

New Felony Offense Parole Violators: juveniles revoked from parole for a new felony offense.

Misdemeanor Violators: juveniles revoked from parole for a new misdemeanor offense.

Technical Parole Violators: juveniles revoked from parole for a technical violation of parole.

Negative Movements: juveniles returned to residential care from parole but not due to revocation or recommitment (e.g., to participate in a hearing).
