#### **MEMORANDUM**

**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Year 2006 Homeland Security Report

The attached report is presented in accordance with Article IX, Sec. 7.10, which requires agencies and institutions of higher education to report homeland security funding, including pass-through funds to local units of government. The report contains fiscal year 2006 federal and state funding by agency and method of finance and is divided into two categories: Terrorist-related and Natural/Man-made Disasters.

Homeland security funding in Texas totaled \$2.2 billion in fiscal year 2006. Of that amount, \$419.4 million (19 percent) was for Terrorist-related activities and \$1.8 billion (81 percent) was for Natural/Man-made Disaster activities. Approximately 98 percent of Terrorist-related funding was Federal, compared to 79 percent of funding for Natural/Man-made Disasters. Attached charts show that 91 percent of expenditures for Terrorist-related purposes were concentrated at four agencies:

- Department of Public Safety
- Department of State Health Services
- Texas Engineering and Extension Service
- UT Medical Branch at Galveston

For Natural/Man-made Disasters, 85 percent of expenditures were made at four agencies:

- Department of Public Safety
- Texas Education Agency
- Texas Workforce Commission
- Health and Human Services Commission

Homeland security funding directly distributed to local entities is not reported to the LBB. Also, the report does not include homeland security expenditures made by federal agencies based in the state, such as the U.S. Customs and Border Protection Agency.


Much of the homeland security funding reported by state agencies was distributed in the form of grants to local entities for such things as hospital preparedness, first responder training and equipment or disaster assistance. Pass-through funds to local entities totaled \$981.8 million in fiscal year 2006. Of that amount \$284.9 million was for Terrorist-related purposes and \$696.9 million was for Natural/Man-made Disaster purposes.


The Department of Public Safety reported pass-through funds to local entities for six Terrorist-related programs totaling \$172.8 million and five Natural/Man-made Disaster programs totaling \$696.9 million. The Department of State Health Services reported pass-through funds to local entities for two Terrorist-related programs totaling \$78.3 million. Texas Engineering Extension Service reported pass-through funds to local entities for five Terrorist-related programs totaling \$33.8 million. Reported pass-through amounts do not include funds from the Texas Education Agency to school districts, allocated according to the number of Hurricane Katrina evacuees attending school and damage related to Hurricane Rita.
