Executive Summary

The following report is a summary of all requests and awards for federal financial assistance in 1998 as reported by each agency and institution of higher education*. Awarded amounts vary from reported actual or estimated federal expenditures and are based on project periods which may not coincide with state or federal fiscal years.

Forty-seven state agencies reported federal awards that totaled \$13.0 billion from September 1, 1997 to August 31, 1998. The ten largest federal programs at Texas agencies accounted for \$10.3 billion or 79.1 percent of that amount. The ten agencies with the largest federal awards accounted for \$12.6 billion or 96.2 percent of the total. Agency information begins on page two of this report.

During the same period, 45 institutions of higher education reported federal awards that totaled \$986.4 million. Of that amount, the ten largest federal programs to universities accounted for \$118.5 million or 12 percent and the ten universities with the largest federal awards accounted for \$891.5 million or 82.8 percent.

Due to the high volume of research awards, universities report an annual aggregate total for research awards below \$500,000 per year. Research awards that exceed \$500,000 per year are reported in the same manner as non-research awards. All research awards are included in this report. Of the total \$986.4 million reported by universities in 1998, research awards below \$500,000 accounted for \$631.7 million or 64 percent. Information about university federal funds begins on page 22 of this report.

Although every effort was made to work closely with agencies and universities to correct obvious errors and to avoid duplicate information, it is important to remember that this data has been neither edited nor verified by the LBB and inaccuracies may exist. Data may be incomplete if agencies failed to comply with reporting deadlines.

The report entitled 1997 Federal Assistance Awards to Texas State Agencies was distributed in October 1997 and the 1997 Federal Assistance Awards to Texas Institutions of Higher Education was distributed under separate cover in December 1997.







1998 Total Awards - \$986.4 Million


