## Criminal and Juvenile Justice Recidivism and Revocation Rates Report: Overview

Recidivism is a return to criminal activity after previous criminal involvement.

Each cohort is followed for three years.

This report uses the following measures to determine recidivism:

- Rearrest; and
- Reincarceration.

Rearrest and reincarceration rates for fiscal years 2012 and 2013 cohorts will be published in February 2017.


