WHAT IS A REPORTABLE CONTRACT?

A reportable contract is an agreement to acquire goods or services that exceeds the dollar thresholds described in the following table. This definition includes contracts, purchase orders, interagency agreements, grants, and any other kind of purchase of goods or services.

WHAT NEEDS TO BE REPORTED?

Contract information must be submitted to the Legislative Budget Board Contracts Database by the required deadline. The solicitation, contract, and any other required documents also must be attached. Some exemptions apply.
